



## **PRONG COLLAR SAFETY CHAIN**

Thank you for your order. It is **extremely** important that you follow these instructions:

This safety chain only works if you have both a normal collar and also a prong collar on your dog. In using this product you are releasing OvernightDog from any liability whatsoever.

- A) Connect one end of the safety chain to the prong collar at a place as close to the leash hook-up as you can. The photo above illustrates one client who hooked it to the same place where the leash is attached (A). This is important because if the prong collar fails, your dog should still be attached to his normal collar. If you attach it to a part that breaks away, so will your dog!
- B) Attach the other end of the safety chain to your dog's normal collar (B).

The Prong Collar Safety Chain should allow the **PRONG COLLAR** to tighten while walking your dog before the **P.C. SAFETY CHAIN** does. The Safety Chain should hang loosely. But not so loose that it trips your dog when he runs. That could be dangerous!

### **USE COMMON SENSE HERE FOLKS:**

**DO NOT use a safety chain that is too long.** It can loop too low, and your dog may get his foot caught in it while running!

**OvernightDog.com** will not be held responsible if you use this device incorrectly, or too often. It is meant only as an emergency back up to your prong collar if that appliance fails. Kind of like the emergency brake on your car.
